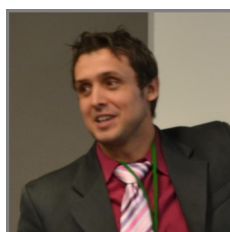

About the SA Survey of Student Engagement (SASSE)

SASSE provides institutions with high-quality data to encourage changes in the learning environment to promote student success. The survey measures student engagement on the basis of four broad themes: academic challenge, learning with peers, experiences with staff and the campus environment. Institutions may use their data to identify aspects of the undergraduate experience inside and outside the classroom that can be improved through changes in policies and practices more consistent with good practices in undergraduate education.

The SASSE survey was conducted at UKZN in 2014. This workshop reflects on the data to guide UKZN users towards effectively utilising their SASSE results to obtain actionable outcomes. The workshop will demonstrate how data can be used diagnostically to provide institutions with information that is actionable and that can enhance the discourse about quality in education from the perspective of teaching, learning and effective educational practices.
